In 2018, more folks than ever took "first steps," attending "Fajitas and Faithbridge," StartingPoint class, being baptized, and even joining as official new members!


Our Student Ministry has grown by more than 10% in the last year — and more than 575 youth and adults went on short-term mission journeys through our ministry called "The Road."






